

## ***Secondary and Adult Ed Plans and Schedules***

- **Jill Wright: Computer Skills:** Word, Excel, keyboarding, accounting, medical terminology, medical billing, and accounting, located at the Education Village in Williams, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, 9:00-3:00. Begins 8/23/2016. This is a class where students proceed at their own pace and celebrate short range goals. Ms. Wright has years of teaching experience and makes the classroom a welcoming place.
- **Dora Maldonado: English as a Second Language (ESL) and Citizenship:** located at Education Village in Williams, Mondays through Thursdays, 6:00 until 9:00. Instructional Assistant: Angelica Velasquez. Begins 9/6/2016. Ms. Maldonado has been teaching the ESL class in Williams and has many satisfied students. Some also accomplish their citizenship through the studies Mrs. Maldonado provides.
- **Lynn Howard: ESL:** located at Pierce High School in Arbuckle, Tuesdays and Thursdays, 6:00 until 8:00. Begins 9/6/2016. **Carol Keiser** twice a month for computer applications of ESL. Begins 9/15/2016. The same help in learning English is available this year in Arbuckle. In addition to the usual ESL training, Ms. Kaiser will provide students with basic computer skills and vocabulary.
- **Lorraine Joy McBurney: General inmate education and preparation for HiSET** Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays at Colusa County Jail, and for anyone who comes to the class at the Probation Daily Reporting Center on Wednesdays from 3:00-5:00. Ms. McBurney lives out her middle name as she takes joy in teaching inmate education and also as she helps students prepare to take the High School Equivalency Test.
- **Eric Johnson: HiSET test** preparation at the Education Village in Williams, Mondays through Thursday, from 6:00 until 9:00. This second location will be more convenient for people living along the I-5 corridor. Begins August 15.
- **The Community School and Colusa County Independent Study School** are located at the Education Village in Williams. For full day students, class begins at 8:15 and ends each day at 2:45. Students doing independent study will meet with the teacher for varying times during regular school days as assigned. The basic curriculum is computer based and electives are mostly hands-on. Begins August 10, 2016.
- **Colusa County Agricultural and Vocational Academy: Paul Cimino**, located at the Education Village in Williams each school day from 8:15 until 2:45.

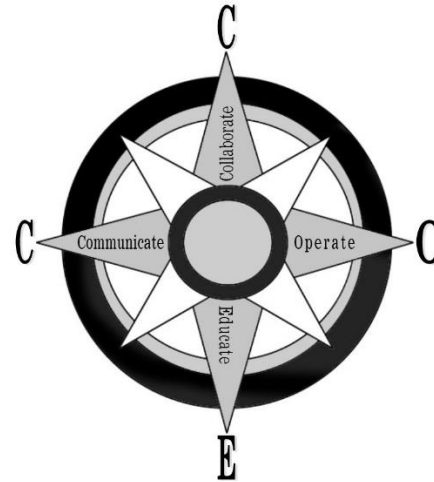
